NO UPFRONT FEES

If you are aged 19 or over and are thinking of improving your career options you can cover the cost of tuition fees with an Advanced Learning Loan. Repayments don't begin until you finish the course and are earning at least £21,000.

This loan can fund many Level 3 & 4 courses, including Access courses, Diplomas, Extended Diplomas and Advanced & Higher Apprenticeships.

If you are 19 or over you can apply from May 2016 for an Advanced Learning Loan, for courses starting on or after 1 August. Loan eligibility doesn't depend on your income and there are no credit checks.*

What's more, students who complete an Access to HE Diploma and then go on to complete a degree have their Advanced Learning Loan written off.

When can I apply?

From May 2016

Yes, if you are:

- 19 or over on the first day of your course. There is no upper age limit
- Starting your course on or after 1 August 2016

Can I get this loan?

- Enrolling on an eligible course at Level 3 or above which includes: Access to HE Diplomas, other Diplomas, Advanced or Higher **Apprenticeships**
- Living in the UK on the first day of the course and have lived in the UK, Channel Islands or Isle of Man for 3 years immediately before this
- · A UK national or have 'settled' status

How do I apply?

Apply to college as normal. Once you receive an offer letter complete a loan application at www.gov.uk/advancedlearningloans
